Purpose of Child Find Activities

Children with disabilities who reside in the State of Tennessee, including homeless children, wards of the State, and children who attend private schools, and who are in need of special education and related services, are identified, located, and evaluated. A practical method is developed and implemented to determine which children are currently receiving special education and related services.



The Monroe County Schools' Child Find program identifies children between the ages of three and twenty-one with special education needs. Educational needs for students are determined through parent interview and child evaluations. Areas evaluated may include speech/language, hearing, vision, motor, cognitive and adaptive development.

Is My Child Eligible for Services?

If you suspect that your child needs additional educational support to achieve his/her educational potential or if you feel that your child is working above potential and needs additional academic enrichment, the Monroe County School System strongly encourages you to contact us. A FREE screening and possibly a full evaluation will be provided to determine if your child is eligible for special services. The Monroe County School System adheres to all Federal and State requirements as outlined in the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) and the State of Tennessee Special Education Eligibility Standards.

Following evaluation, if a child is determined to meet State eligibility standards and is in need of special services, an Individual Education Program (IEP) will be developed and an appropriate program will be offered to meet the child's educational needs.

What are Special Services?

Special Education is a program of specially designed instruction and related services to meet each individual child's needs. It is provided to all eligible students under the federal law, Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA), Public Law 102-119.
